ADRIAN F. LEVY, JR.
1919-2008

WHEREAS, ADRIAN F. LEVY, JR., known to us as Adrian, departed this life on December 10, 2008 at the age of 89.

WE, THE ROTARY CLUB OF GALVESTON, DO HEREBY RESOLVE, THAT:

Our Club mourns the loss of Adrian Levy, a highly respected and valued member of our Club.

Adrian was born on October 4, 1919 in Galveston to Adrian and Pearl Levy. He was a fourth generation BOI. Adrian was a lifelong resident of Galveston where he dedicated his life to his career as an attorney, civic volunteer, husband and father. He graduated from Ball High School and four years later, Harvard. He then received his law degree from The University of Texas but put his law career on hold by answering the call of his country during World War II. Adrian served as a Captain in the Army Air Corps in Europe. He served with the 390th Heavy Bomb Group of the famed 8th Air Force. He was very proud of his military service and always praised the brave men he served with. When he returned from the War, he joined his

father's law firm and practiced there until he retired at 65. He was known as a brilliant lawyer who practiced law with dignity, integrity and honor. He represented many of Galveston's most well to do families but always generously volunteered his time and talent to help the poor and downtrodden as well.

Adrian was very active in the Galveston community. He worked for many years as a volunteer Merit Badge Coordinator for the Boy Scouts and served on the Board of Frost Bank. He served as president of his beloved Temple B'nai Israel and spent his entire life working for the good of the Temple.

We will always remember Adrian as a great member and leader of our Rotary Club. Adrian's Rotary membership spanned 57 years. Adrian truly lived his life in accordance with our Rotary motto of "SERVICE ABOVE SELF."

The Rotary Club of Galveston wishes to note, with deep regret , the passing of Adrian Levy, Jr., a loyal member, cherished friend and exceptional man. We bestow our sincere sympathy to his family and friends.
