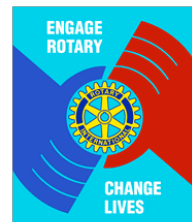

Jerry Ross, astronaut, spoke about his travels to outer space. He was in NASA for 33 years and has made seven trips to outer space, and has walked in outer space nine times. He was selected to be an astronaut in 1980.

He played a video showing highlights of his last flight in April 2002. He and his crew traveled to the International Space Station. During their orbit around the Earth, those on board witnessed a sunrise and a sunset every 90 minutes.

His wife, Karen, helped prepare food the astronauts brought with them.

The official language on the space station is English. Russian is also spoken.

When entering the Earth's atmosphere, the space shuttle is traveling 25 times the speed of sound.
