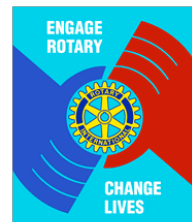

Libbie's place is Galveston's senior adult day care facility. The facility offers monthly support group meetings for caregivers and UTMB also offers caregiver education. It is a licensed facility and does charge for services. They work with veterans and long-term care insurance policies to help defray costs.

Participants can take part in many activities including exercising, playing cards, gardening, watching movies, art projects, board games, daily devotionals and socializing with others during coffee and meals.
