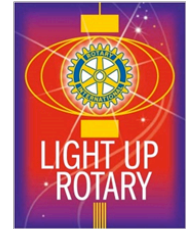

Program

John Zendt introduced the program: Hud Hopkins, manager of Scholes International Airport.

The airport occupies 1,200 acres and sees 110 operations per day. Most of its revenue comes from non-aviation sources, tenants that include Schlitterbahn, Moody Gardens and Inn at the Water Park.

Before Hurricane Ike, the airport was home to three flight schools. It is working to attract one. The airport is looking to add BP to its client list. This would mean 9,000 people per week moving through the airport.

As for commercial service, like Southwest, Hud said it's up to Galvestonians to support it.
